
As you are aware, on May 13, 2005, GO Transit's Board of Directors voted to upgrade the EA to an individual environmental assessment in response to concerns raised by the community. While Transport Canada is concerned about the potential for delay that may result from this action, the department respects the decision of its provincial partners.

As part of the upgraded process, the assessment will examine all alternatives to ensure that the project will provide the best service to the citizens of the Greater Toronto Area while remaining sensitive to impact on adjacent residents. You may be interested to know that SNC Lavalin has withdrawn from undertaking the EA. This action will eliminate any perception of a conflict of interest and ensure that the project can proceed as quickly as possible.

In closing, I would like to assure you that the EA process will harmonize both the federal and the provincial processes.
