Dear Mayor Miller:

We, the members of the Mount Dennis Residents Association wish to inform you that we have formally endorsed (by vote at our meeting of October 5) the concept of a subway line along the CN Rail corridor to the airport, as proposed by the Weston Community Coalition. We feel this project will help our community by providing better access to public transportation for our 12,000 residents, revitalize stores and businesses within our community as well as provide a great alternative to the noise and vibrations that would be caused by the proposed rail link.

The federal and provincial government's proposal for a single-stop private railroad falls far short of what the city needs and wants for rapid transit. We believe that public funds should be spent on public transit, and there are significant federal, provincial, and municipal funds earmarked for this private Air-Rail Link. We believe that building a better city includes building public transportation infrastructures, including new subway lines.
